Limited Period Referral Program

Terms and Conditions

Applicable Timeline

Limited Period Referral Program will be applicable for all referrals received for September intake during the Period January 1st 2025 to October 30th 2025 for any of the BTEC programs of UK College of Business and Computing.

Limited Period Referral Program Applicability

The Referral Program is applicable for the following demographics:

1. Ongoing Students of UK College of Business and Computing. All students who are eligible for payments under the referral scheme must be up to date on their fee payments for them to be eligible for the payment.
2. Parents of ongoing students of the UK College of Business and Computing
3. External referral's are accepted ONLY from those who have registered their interest in the prescribed application form after being approved by the relevant committee / CEO
4. Alumni of UKCBC who have successfully completed their course from UKCBC and have no pending dues as on closing of the September intake.
5. Partner Institutions which have a referral agreement have to specifically indicate interest as per their existing scheme to migrate to this scheme during the period.
6. Employees and their next of kin are not part of the Limited Period Referral Program.

Referral Program Rewards

1. Referral Program Rewards shown is cumulative payment applicable for the specified number of students who are referred and enrolled as per the Limited Period Referral Program.
2. All payments up to and including the first 4 slabs will be completed after 8 weeks of commencement of classes of the September intake, all other payments will be done 4 weeks after receipt of the full tuition fees from the referred student.
3. Referred Students are applicable to UK College of Business and Computing discounts and/or merit scholarships as per UK College of Business and Computing policy. However, total of (Discounts + Other Benefits + Referral Rewards) will not exceed 50% of the total tuition fees of the student.
4. Exceptions to above rule is applicable only with prior approval from the referring party to reduce their referral reward, such that the total payment under the Limited Period Referral Program will be reduced in such a manner that the total of (Discounts + Other Benefits + Referral Rewards) does not exceed 50% of the tuition fees.

In such cases, the student will still count towards achievement of the relevant student number irrespective of the total exceeding the 50% of the tuition fees and the impact is only on the reward.

Above condition is illustrated in the below 2 examples -

- a) Eg: Student A referred 1 student for the merit scholarship program and was offered a 70% discount on the tuition fees. He / she will not be eligible for referral payout as the total tuition fee discount exceeded 50%
- b) Eg: Student A and B referred 4 students for a course with Tuition fees of 28,000 with some at merit scholarship and others at different fees. The computation of referral fees payable under two scenarios is explained for a better understanding.

50% of the total Tuition Fees	56,000	56,000
Total Tuition Fees collected from Referred Students after Discounts	67,200	59,000
Total available for payment of referral fees (Excess over 50% Tuition Fees)	11,200	3,000
Referral Fees Eligible	7,001	7,001
Actual Referral Payment based on total not exceeding 50%	7,001	3,000

Referral Validity

1. All Referral leads received from Monday 5th of June are considered under the Limited Period Referral Program by default.
2. Referrals which are counted towards the old Referral Program will not be part of the number achievement for incremental references under the new Limited Period Referral Program.
3. In cases where a referral lead has already made a direct enquiry and is registered with UK College of Business and Computing prior to the reference being received from the referee, UK College of Business and Computing will reject the reference.
4. In cases where multiple people are observed to have referred the same student, preference shall be extended to the first person who referred the enquiry.
5. All references are valid for a period of 30 days starting from the date of receipt of the reference. If the student does not enroll within the 30 days of receipt of the reference, then the decision to award / not award the student as a referral will be at the sole discretion of UKCBC management.
6. UKCBC Management reserves the right to discontinue / alter the Limited Period Referral Program at any time during the period and the decision of the management will be final and binding on all parties in case of any disputes on the Referral Program.
7. If you have already referred someone on the Old Referral Program and they have not yet signed the Offer letter, you may request the Administration to change the referral to the new Limited Period Referral Program to increase your rewards.
